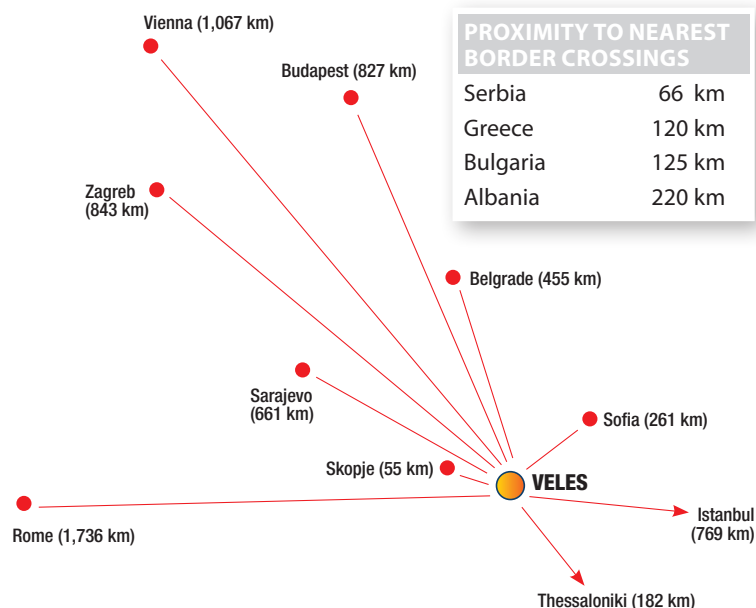

Located in the heart of Macedonia, the Municipality of Veles is the main crossroad connecting the entire country with the international Corridor 10 that links the Mediterranean sea, Middle East and Africa. International railroad lines (Belgrade – Skopje – Veles – Thessaloniki and Shtip – Veles – Bitola) and proximity to international airport “Alexander the Great” in Skopje (30 km away) additionally strengthen the excellent geo-strategic position of Veles. There are several developed industries the municipality, including construction materials industry, food, leather, textile, ceramics, commerce, metal industry, agriculture, services. Some of the most successful companies operating in Veles are Tuš markets, Brako, Leov, Dimko Mitrev, Blagoj Gjorev, Žito Markets. The city is open for new investors and the local government continues to work on improving the business climate and provide potential investors with the necessary support for building strong companies. The industrial zones formed by the local government offer infrastructurally equipped land which can be acquired at a price of only € 1 per m², and a variety of other benefits in terms of geographical location, climate conditions, water resources, transportation corridors and human resource. With a beautiful lake, archeological sites and specific architecture, Veles offers a highly pleasant environment to work and live in.
