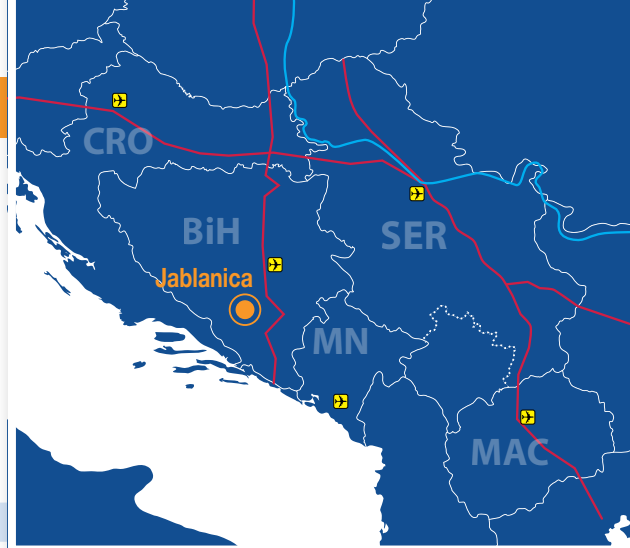


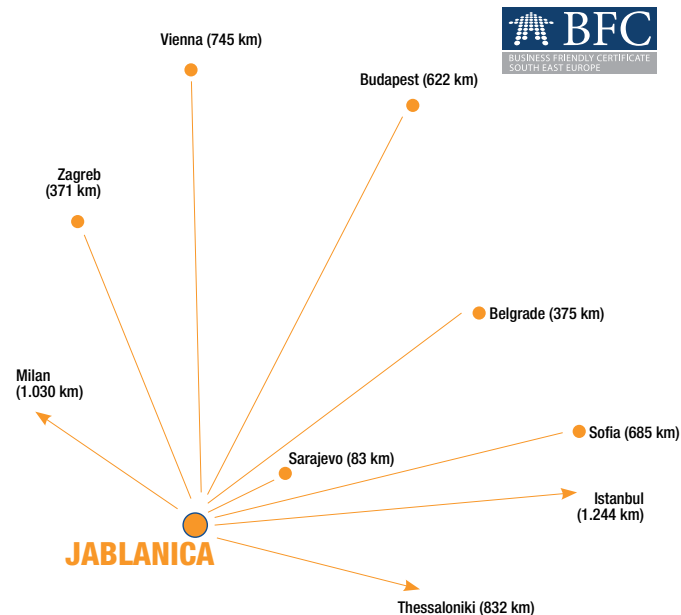

Jablanica is located at the intersection of main roads Sarajevo - Mostar and Mostar - Banja Luka. Proximity to the EU border and good transport connections rank Jablanica among the most favorable positioned municipalities in the region. The key sectors in terms of economic development potential include the exploitation and processing of stone and gypsum, agricultural production, tourism and hospitality. Jablanica has a hundred-year tradition in stone processing and unique properties of granite stone make the municipality a regional center in this area of work, with 9 locations of research and exploitation. Jablanica granite covers an area of approximately 17 km² with exploitation reserves of 800,000 m². Agricultural land covers 15% of the municipal territory and has enormous potential for organic farming and the production of early-season vegetables and other produces. What distinguishes Jablanica from its peers is its efficient local government which continuously works on improving its efficiency and services to citizens and business community. Through Municipal Council for Competitiveness, Jablanica has established extensive communication between the public and private sector. Furthermore, the municipality offers numerous benefits for those wishing to develop or expand their business, including the incentives and support for start-ups and agricultural production.
